



Flavors other than tobacco are prohibited in NY since May 2020




Most Common Cannabis Products:

On average, products contained 45 mg/mL of nicotine

Nicotine concentration ranged from 4.4 to 161 mg/mL

Each device contained nicotine equivalent to 7-13 packs of cigarettes

84 (18%) products contained other substances

- 84 products contained THC**
- 13 products contained CBD**

W On average, products contained 450.6 mg of total cannabinoids

<u>No other illicit substances were detected (e.g. fentanyl)</u>

People who have never used cannabis can feel effects after consuming only 2.5 mg
